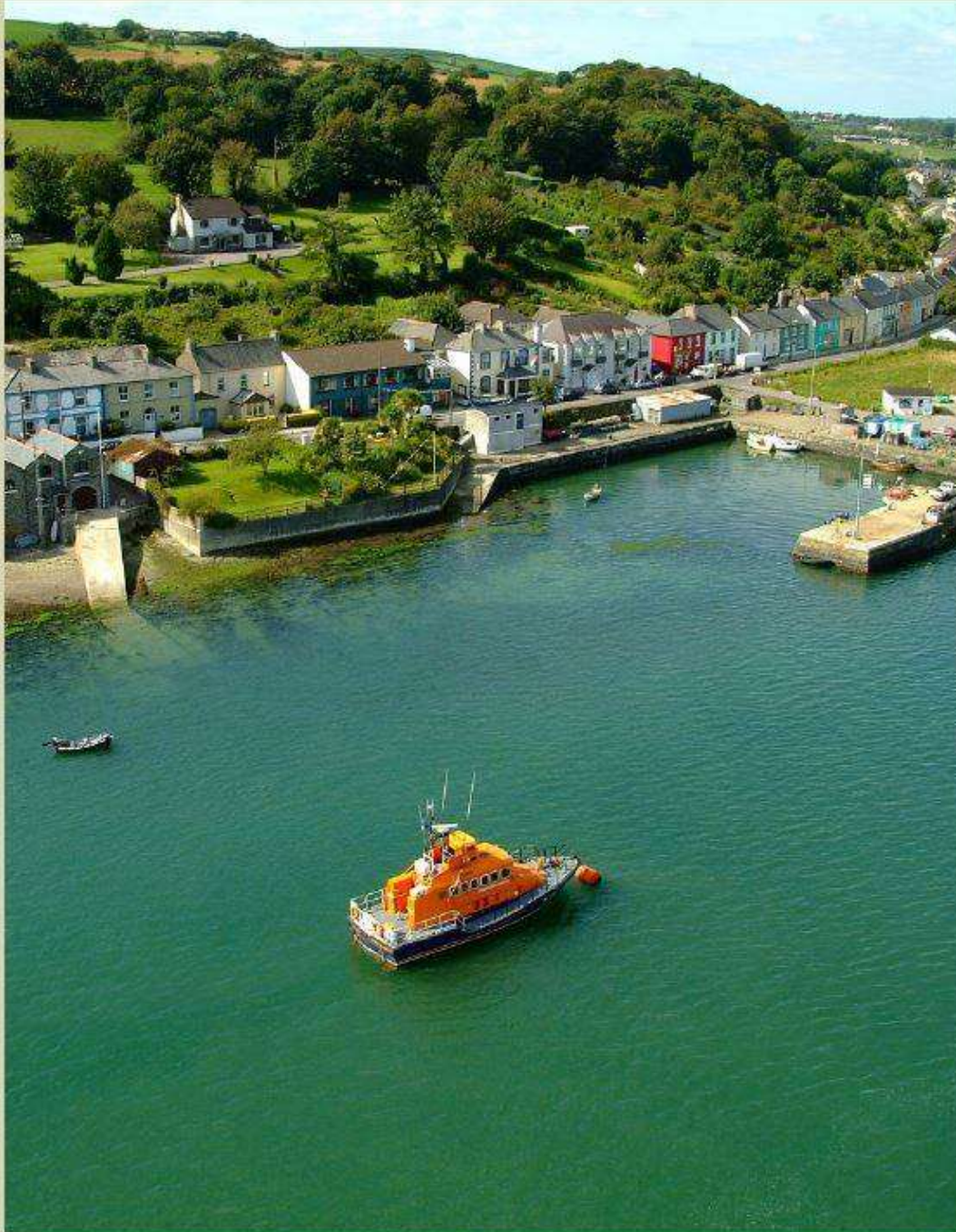

General Information.

1. Directions:

On Arrival in Courtmacsherry proceed through the village to Courtmacsherry Rowing Club which is located past the Hotel and caravan park adjacent to the beach.

2. Event Details:

a. Training / Preview of the course Saturday 17th Sept 10am to 12.30pm.

b. Heats Saturday 17th Sept 1.30pm to 7pm.

c. Finals Sunday 18th September 10am to 3pm

d. Prize Giving Sunday 18th September 3.30pm.

3. Boat Storage, Boat Launching & Crew Change overs:

a. Boat storage will be adjacent to Courtmacsherry Pier for the duration of the event. The boat storage area will be secure overnight on Friday 16th and Saturday 17th.

b. Boat launching and crew changes will all take place from Courtmacsherry Rowing Club which is located at the end of Courtmachserry Village adjacent to the beach.

4. Course details:

a. The heats & Finals will be raced over a 4k course – see attached map for details. The co-ordinates of each turn will be issued 48 hours in advance of the start of the event.

b. The 4km course starts at the mouth of Courtmacsherry harbour and runs parallel to the shore into the prevailing sea swell for 1.2km. It then turns left into leg 2 and heads out to sea for 947m, rowing across the sea swell. The course then turns left again into leg 3 which runs for 640m, where you will be rowing with the prevailing sea swell. The course then turns left into leg 4 which runs for 510m, here you will be across the swell again in the opposite direction. The last turn is a right hand turn into the homeward leg which runs for 725m with the prevailing sea swell.

5. Course viewing:

a. All racing can be viewed from the “Point of the Wood” which is located approx. 800 meters from Courtmacsherry Rowing Club.

b. The viewing is accessed on foot using the “seven heads” walk way.

c. The route from Courtmacsherry Rowing Club to the viewing area will be clearly signposted.

d. Everybody going to the viewing area must keep to the path way at all times.

6. Prize Giving:

The prize giving will take place at Courtmacsherry Community Centre at 3.30pm on Sunday 18th September. Refreshments will be provided at the prize giving.

7. Food:

Courtmacsherry Rowing Club will be operating a refreshments stand (Tea, Coffee, Homemade sandwiches, Home baking treats etc) at the viewing area on Saturday and Sunday all will be reasonably priced. In addition there are various food outlets in the village of Courtmacsherry and surrounding area for more substantial meals.

Race Entries & Provisional Schedule

Boat availability is the determining factor in establishing the schedule. At the time of publication we are confident that the required boats to run the published schedule are available. Below where a boat has not yet been allocated note that we are in the process of securing these boats. However if this changes in the lead up to the event it will be necessary to adjust the schedule accordingly by introducing additional heats,

	1	Courtmacsherry 1	Progression Method: A maximum of 9 boats can proceed to the A&B finals. Castletownbere will have to finish in one of the top 9 positions for this to occur. The finishing position of Castletownbere will determine if the A or the B final will have 5 boats. If Castletownbere either win their heat or are one of the fastest two runners up then the A final will be 5 boats otherwise the B final will be 5 boats. The winner of each heat will go through to the A Final. The fastest Runner up of all three heats will go through to the A final. (If Castletownbere are in the top 4 boats then the 2nd fastest runner up of all three heats will also go through to the A final.) This will result
